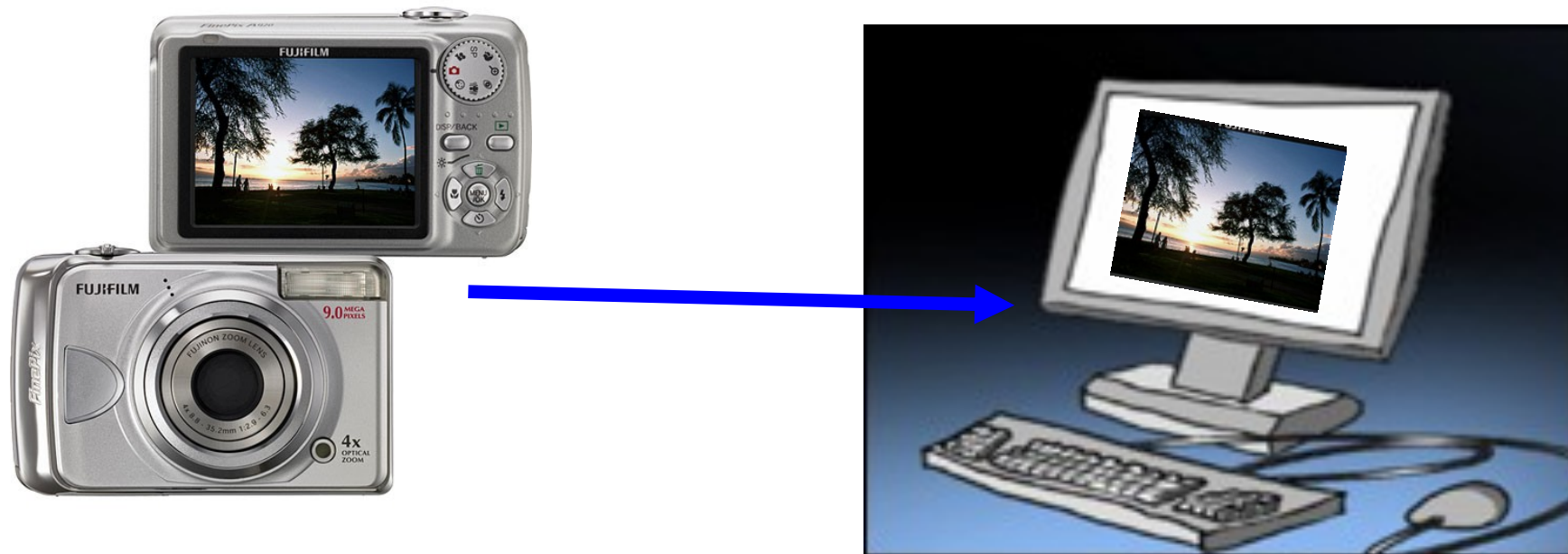

# Downloading Photographs from a camera.





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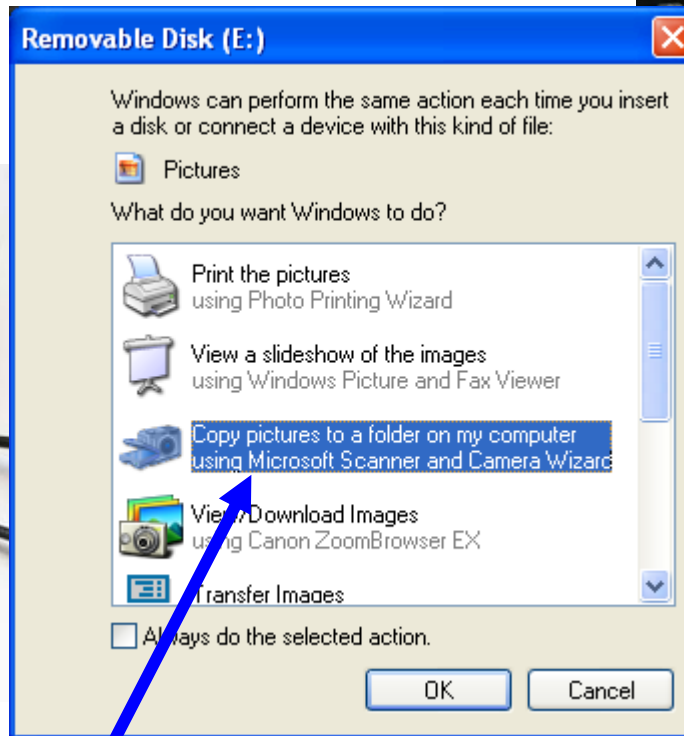
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 **Digital Cameras** come with USB slots and a cable to connect to the computer.



When either is inserted into their respective slots... This dialogue will appear on your screen. (below)



In this guide—we'll select ( ) This one. Click the OK button.

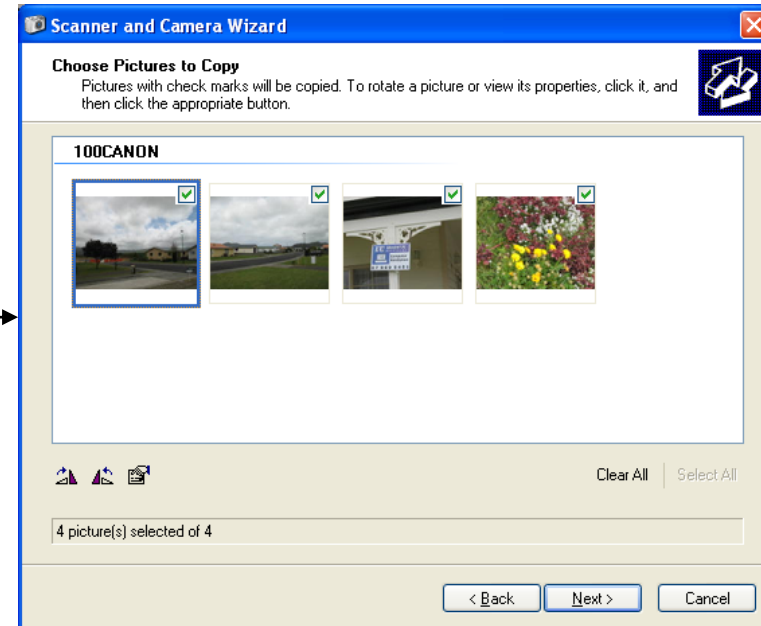
 They also come with Memory Cards. Like film in analogue cameras.



You can take this out of your camera and insert it into the card reader in your computer.



*This is the Windows wizard...*

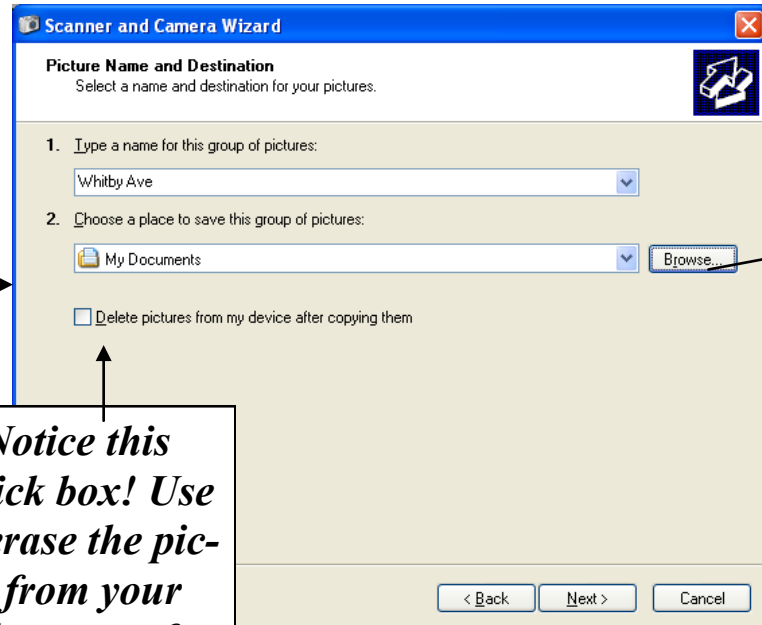


**Notice the tick boxes. A tick means you want the picture, a clear box will not download that photograph.**



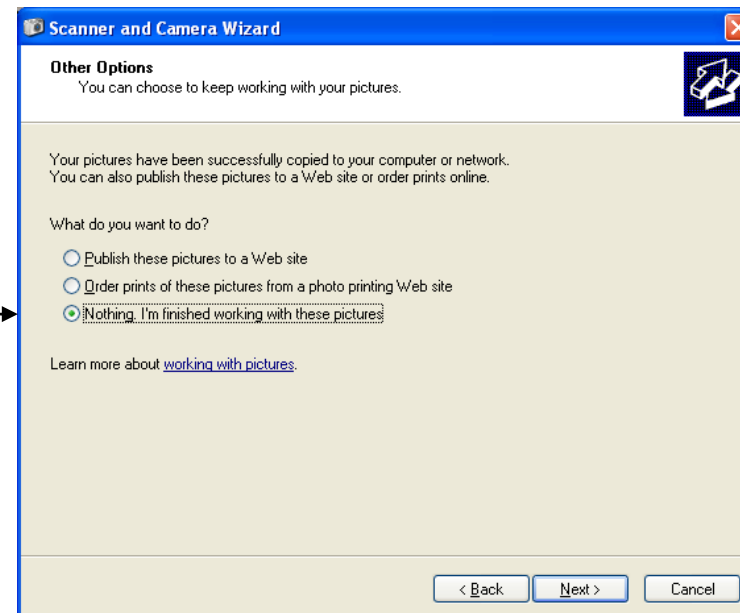


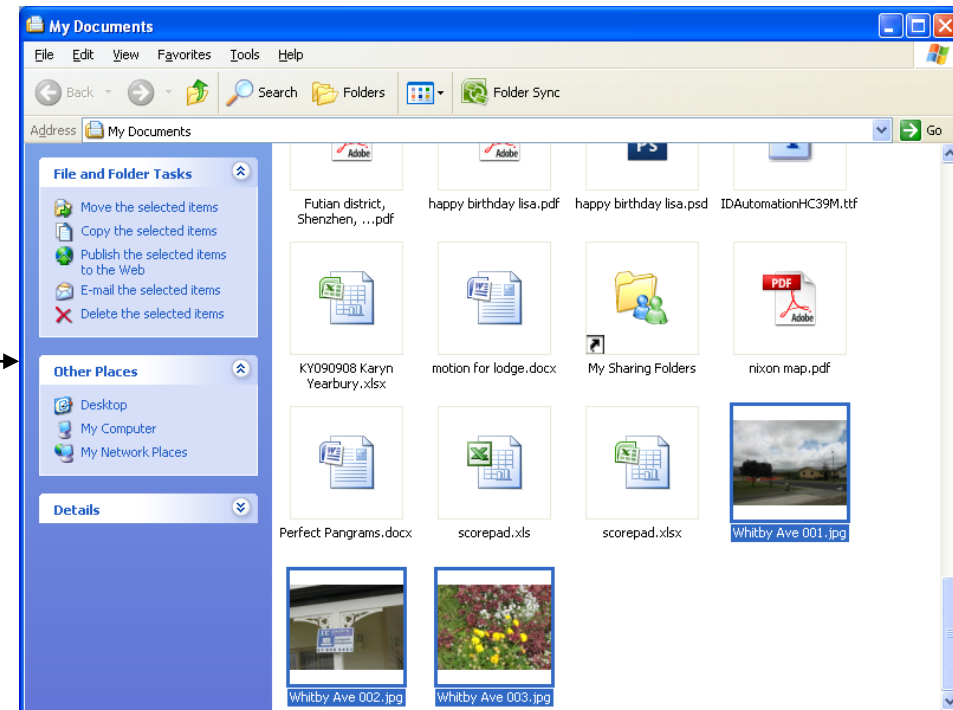
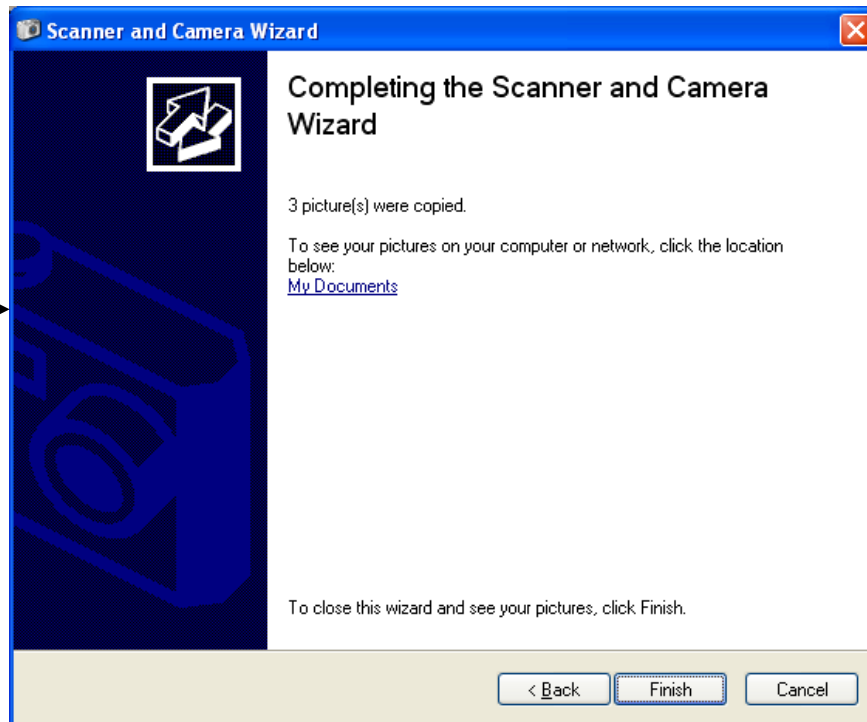
*Clicking the

**On this screen you

**When you click Finish, Windows™ will show your pictures to you in the place that you specified. Notice the collective name given to the photographs.**
